What is Portable Appliance testing? (PAT Testing)

PAT Testing involves testing all electrical equipment for any faults, which may cause accidents and injuries.



According to the Health & safety Executive 25% of all reportable electrical accidents are due to faulty portable appliances.

Who Needs PAT Testing?

If you are a **business owner** or **landlord** then you have a duty of care to your staff or tenants to ensure that any electrical appliances provided are **safe** to use.

This includes any appliances in shops, offices, hotels, guest & public houses, schools, leased & rented accommodation, cafes, restaurants, public buildings, residential homes and construction sites.

PAT Testing Process

Portable appliance testing begins with a through visual inspection of the appliance before a series of tests are carried out using professional PAT testing equipment. The appliance being tested is then given a pass or a fail sticker as appropriate.

A certificate and asset register is used upon completion of the testing.
